

PARENTS MEETING ON LONG TERM INTERNSHIP



DONATION OF SANITARY PADS.








Admission campaign in various Junior colleges'


BOTANY STUDENTS' FIELD TRIP






COMPETITIONS ON THE EVE OF REPUBLIC DAY



STAFF MEETING


