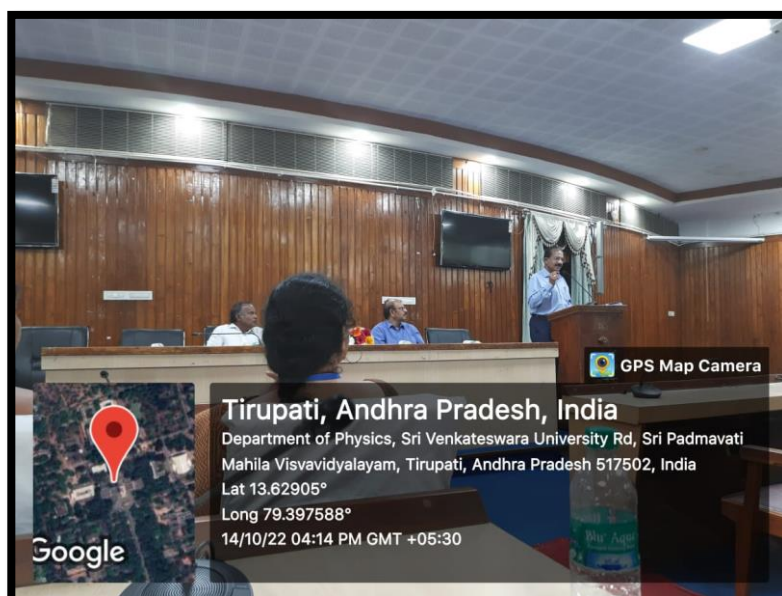
UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS
