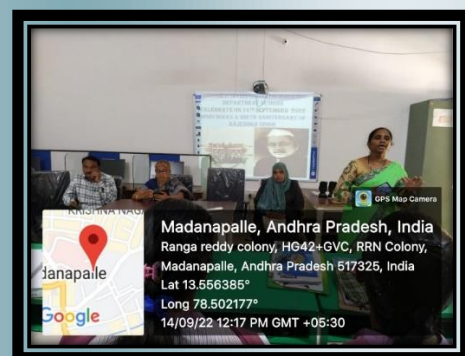
3. Zonal Review Meeting-08-09-2022 :

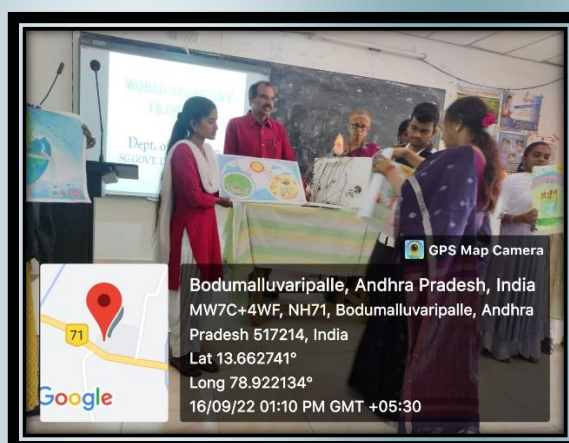
6. International Democracy Day -15-09-2022 :

10.Celebration of Peace Day by Department of Political Science-21-09-2022

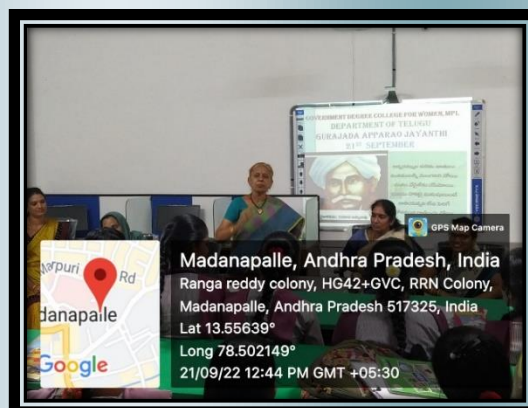
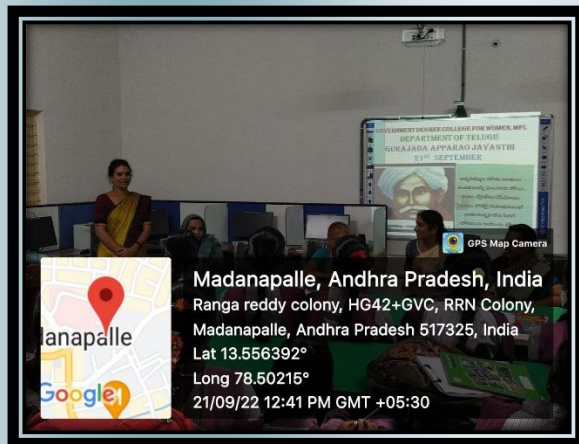

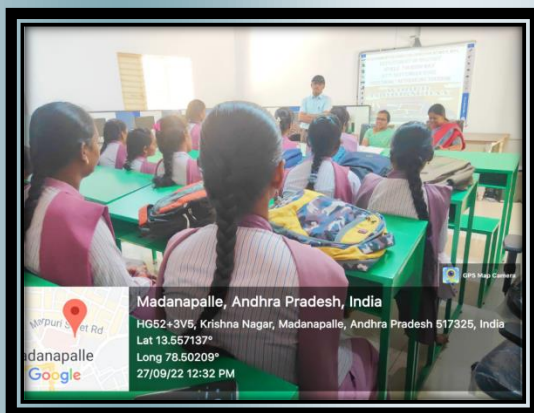
18. Chilakhamarthy Lakshmi Narsimha Jayanti by Telugu Department-26-09-2022

Chilakamarti Lakshmi Narasimham was an Indian playwright, novelist and author of short stories, who wrote in the Telugu language. He was a romantic and a social reformer in the tradition founded by Veeresalingam. His best-known plays are probably Gayopakhyanam and Ganapati.

Often referred to as Mahakavi, or Navayuga Kavi, Jashuva is a Sahitya Academy awardee. He has also received the Padma Bhushan, and has been conferred the honorary doctorate of Kala Prapoorna by Andhra University.



21. Death anniversary of Mulk Raj Anand (12 December 1905 – 28 September 2004).

A programme in Commemoration of the death anniversary of Mulk Raj Anand (12 December 1905 – 28 September 2004). He was an Indian writer in English, recognised for his depiction of the lives of the poorer castes in traditional Indian society. One of the pioneers of Indo-Anglian fiction, he, together with R. K. Narayan, and Raja Rao, was one of the first India-based writers in English to gain an International readership.
